## A note from the Principal

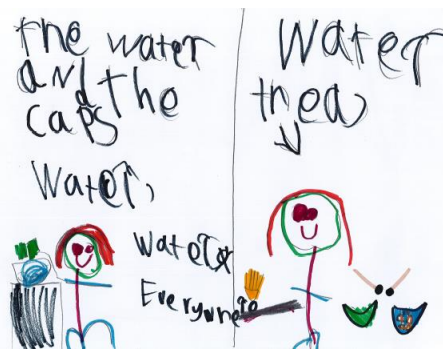


