Numeracy

The focus this term will be:

- Multiplication
- Measurement
- Fractions
- Money

Science

Students will investigate the questions: "What is that? Is it alive? How is it like other things I know?" Through hands-on activities, students will investigate how living things can be grouped on the basis of observable features and can be distinguished from non-living things.
