### Numeracy

### Literacy

#### Writing

During term 3, we will be focussing on recount writing. During this topic the emphasis will be placed on word choice and sentence structure.

#### Reading

Students will be encouraged to continue implementing reading strategies that have been taught. Building on this we will focus on distinguishing between fact and opinion and making inferences (reading between the lines).

### Inquiry

Students will be introduced to democracy in the context of the familiar and personal as well as the purpose of local government and the services it provides to the community. Students will consider the purpose of creating rules for groups and how rules and laws affect them.

### Art

This coming term students will be looking at the work of a number of artists. This will provide inspiration for students' own artwork and enable them to widen their experiences in using a range of materials and techniques.
