Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge

Sunbury Heights is taking part in this year's Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge. The Challenge is open to all students and aims to inspire a lifelong love of reading. It's not a competition – it's a personal challenge for students to read a set number of books by Friday, 5th September 2025.



Students are encouraged to read or 'experience' 30 books with the support of their parents and teachers. This includes 20 books from the Challenge list and 10 free choice books.

Year 3 - Year 6:

Students are challenged to read 15 books independently, with 10 from the Challenge list and 5 free choice books. All children who complete the Challenge will receive a certificate signed by the Victorian Premier and former Premiers – a wonderful keepsake to celebrate their reading achievements! This year marks the 20th anniversary of the Challenge with the theme:

"20 Years of Words and Wonder" – and there will be special activities throughout the year to celebrate. Since it began in 2005, over 4.5 million children have participated, reading more than 63 million books! Happy Reading.

Parent Volunteers & WWCC

Today we held a Volunteer **Induction Session for families** interested in helping out at SHPS. We know how much of a difference our amazing parent helpers make to the day-to-day running of our school. As part of our induction, we've had numerous enquiries about the Working with Children Check (WWCC) and who needs one. A WWCC is required for anyone working with children on a regular basis – such as events, or other school activities. There are also times when having a WWCC is essential, such as assisting in classrooms, at Breakfast Club, or even volunteering at your child's local sports club. The Working with Children Check is free for volunteers, and application forms are available at any Australia Post office. REMINDERS

\$400 School Saving Bonus

The School Saving Bonus (SSB) is a one-off support of \$400 for eligible government school students from Prep to Year 12 in 2025.

The SSB can be used for uniforms and school activities until Monday 30 June 2025. Any funds remaining after 30 June 2025, including uniform voucher amounts that have not been redeemed, will become a credit to use on school activities. However, the credit will not be available on your family account at our school until late July. The Department of Education's SSB contact centre will remain available until 30 June 2025.
