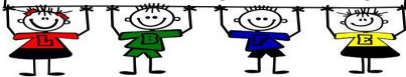

Science Week and Book Week sparked creativity and discovery in classrooms, while a special author visit and participation in the Premier's Reading Challenge inspired a love of reading. Our Robotics Team showcased their skills in a Robotics event, challenging other schools in the process. Sport was another highlight, with SHPS athletes proudly representing the school at Interschool Athletics, Division Athletics, Rugby Gala Days, and Summer Sports. Meanwhile, regular favourites such as Park It Wednesdays and Breakfast Club (Tuesday to Thursday) continued to bring students and families together each week. Behind the scenes, staff were also committed to their own professional learning, including Berry Street training, helping to ensure we continue to provide the very best support for every student. Funds raised will support a worthy cause chosen by our Year 5/6 leaders, giving them the opportunity to make a positive impact on our community.
