

Our Whole School Mini Olympics is quickly approaching. Each class has been assigned a country: 5C Chile, 5MW South Africa, 5/6L Philippines, 6A India and 6K Fiji. Students will compete in a range of tabloid style events, raising as many points for their country as they can. Summer Sports will also be held in the last few weeks of Term 3. Student can choose to try out for basketball, volleyball, softball or lawn bowls. Students who are successful in making a team will go on to represent Sunbury Heights in our District Summer Sports Lightening Premiership.

In our weekly PE sessions our focus is on improving flexibility, strength, speed and agility in a Ninja warrior crossed with gymnastics inspired unit.



This term in STEAM students will be exploring simple circuits and their components in the unit 'Exciting Electricity.' They will investigate concepts such as the movement of negatively charged particles and how for an electrical current to flow there must be a closed circuit.



During Term 3 in Auslan we will be covering: Emotions and Feelings, The Zones of Regulation (feelings/behaviour); signs related to the Social Justice 'Care for Kids' (classroom) Inquiry Unit; Sports; Auslan Handshapes and finally, International Week of Deaf People. We will also revise the new and previously learnt signs.

This term, Year 6 students will gain skills in modelling as they make basic forms for creating a mask. Year 5 students will continue with model-making, as well as explore and engage in printing processes.
