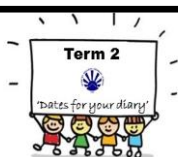

JUST ONE THING



There are 9 minutes during the day that the greatest impact on a child:

- The first 3 minutes right after they wake up.
- The 3 minutes after they come home from school.
- The last 3 minutes of the day before they go to bed.

**Make those minutes special and help our children feel special, loved and accepted.**

- Each day children need meaningful eye-to-eye conversations with a parent. It is especially important to slow down and look them in the eye. Listen and respond with love.
- Hug your child, straighten her hair, pat him on the back and tell them how proud you are of him/her everyday. A simple touch makes them feel connected to a parent in ways that words never will. Remember, actions speak louder than words.
